VOTE, November 2, 1965, on PROPOSITION NUMBER TWO (Chap. 377, Laws of 1965)--Providing for an increase of nine million dollars in the maximum aggregate amount of state periodic subsidies for the payment of which in any one year contracts may be outstanding pursuant to the public housing law and authorizing the creation of additional state debt and the sale of state bonds in the aggregate amount of two hundred million dollars for slum clearance and low rent housing purposes under and pursuant to article eighteen of the constitution.
