Proposal 18-1	A proposed initiated law to authorize and legalize possession, use and cultivation of marijuana products by individuals who are at least 21 years of age and older, and commercial sales of marijuana through state-licensed retailers	
This proposal would:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Allow individuals 21 and older to purchase, possess and use marijuana and marijuana-infused edibles, and grow up to 12 marijuana plants for personal consumption. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Impose a 10-ounce limit for marijuana kept at residences and require amounts over 2.5 ounces be secured in locked containers. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Create a state licensing system for marijuana businesses and allow municipalities to ban or restrict them. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Permit retail sales of marijuana and edibles subject to a 10% tax, dedicated to implementation costs, clinical trials, schools, roads, and municipalities where marijuana businesses are located.

Proposal 18-3	A proposal to authorize automatic and Election Day voter registration, no-reason absentee voting, and straight ticket voting; and add current legal requirements for military and overseas voting and post-election audits to the Michigan Constitution	
This proposed constitutional amendment would allow a United States citizen who is qualified to vote in Michigan to:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Become automatically registered to vote when applying for, updating or renewing a driver's license or state-issued personal identification card, unless the person declines. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Simultaneously register to vote with proof of residency and obtain a ballot during the 2-week period prior to an election, up to and including Election Day. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Obtain an absent voter ballot without providing a reason. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cast a straight-ticket vote for all candidates of a particular political party when voting in a partisan general election.
